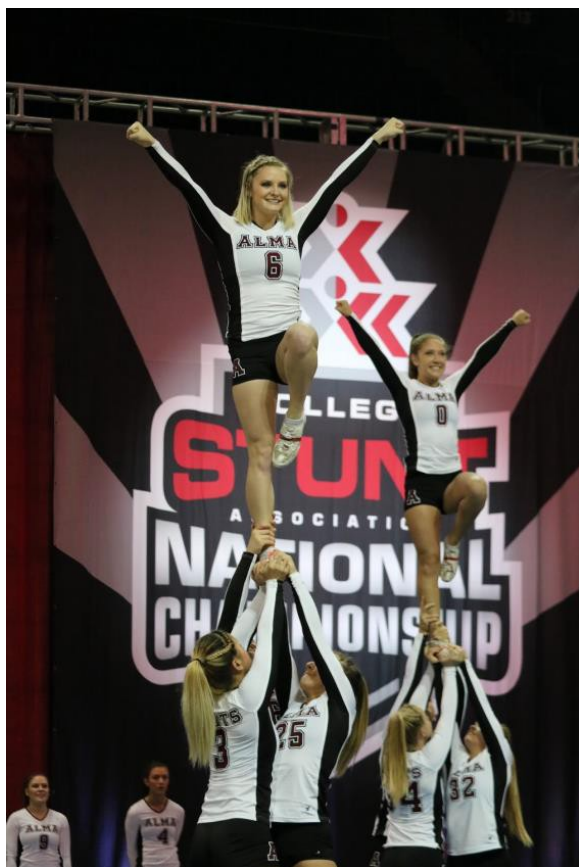

CWA STUNT Support Letter Addendum

Alma College approved the addition of STUNT as its 25th Varsity sport and 13th women's sport in the winter of 2012. As a varsity sport, the college pulled its full support behind the program, starting with a nationwide search for a full-time head coach. The program was given a full budget with start-up funds, and complete access to athletic training and strength and conditioning, the same as the other NCAA sports at the institution.

In addition to the supplied benefits above, the Alma College STUNT team is held to the same expectations for the other NCAA sports in terms of eligibility, compliance, and behavior. All STUNT athletes complete the college NCAA compliance forms at the start of the season and attend all mandatory NCAA meetings.

From 2012-2016 the Alma College STUNT team practiced in the main arena and auxiliary gym. In October 2016, construction was completed on a 3.6 million dollar addition which included a dedicated space in the Hogan Athletic Building for the STUNT team to practice. This space is where the current team practices and includes a trampoline, safety harness, two air tracks, mirrors, 14 mat strips, and a dedicated team locker room for the STUNT athletes to use.

Alma College fully supports the STUNT team as a varsity sport and has included them in all athletic awards since its inception. The STUNT team has won team of the year three times (2015, 2018, 2019) and coach of the year twice (2014, 2018). STUNT has representation in SAAC and had an athlete serve as SAAC president for the 2018-2019 academic year. The head STUNT coach, Michelle Sabourin, also serves as a SAAC advisor.

USA was instrumental in the start of our program with guiding the process and helping us host tournaments at Alma College. STUNT has become a premier sport at our institution and Alma College fully supports the mission of USA cheer to gain emerging sport status.
