Listed below are the addendum responses regarding Davenport University's STUNT program.

Do your STUNT athletes get the same treatment as other athletes on campus?

Our STUNT program is considered a varsity program at Davenport University and follows the same requirements as all other athletic programs on campus. Our STUNT student-athletes receive the same benefits and treatment as all of our student-athletes.

Are you STUNT athletes able to win awards through the athletic department like other varsity athletes?

Yes, our STUNT student-athletes are eligible to receive athletic department awards similar to all other varsity student-athletes at Davenport.

Do they have practice space on campus or do they have to rent off site bc not enough room? Do they get priority like other varsity sports? If they have to go off site, do other teams also have to go off site?

Our STUNT team does have access to our facilities and practices on campus as well as uses facilities off campus. This standard is the similar to our varsity athletic programs. We have varsity programs that also practice off campus at times during the year.

Are there local games/tournaments they're able to travel to?

Our STUNT programs has approved operational dollars to travel to contests/tournaments in state, out of state and out of region just like our varsity athletic programs at Davenport University.
