This letter is on behalf of Oklahoma STUNT Officials Association (OKSOA), in support of requesting the NCAA Committee on Women's Athletics (CWA) to add STUNT as an emerging sport.

Oklahoma has been participating in STUNT since 2012. The first STUNT State Championship was held in 2015. During the 2019 season, 26 high school teams from around the state participated in STUNT, with Large-School and Small-School State Champions being crowned this past April. STUNT has also expanded to JV, middle school, and youth teams across the state. The growth and success of college STUNT in Oklahoma in the past few years has sparked a great interest for athletes and coaches. We anticipate continued participation increase for the 2020 season. It is our goal for STUNT to be adopted by the Oklahoma Secondary School Athletics Association as a sport in the near future.

Adding STUNT as an emerging sport at the collegiate level would open so many opportunities for these high school athletes to continue their higher education by giving them an avenue through STUNT the sport scholarships.

A large majority of OKSOA officials are current or former collegiate STUNT athletes in Oklahoma. It is a great way for these athletes to promote collegiate STUNT at the grassroots levels, giving STUNT an amazing opportunity to cultivate quicker than other sports.
