Spring 2018 – Participate in scrimmages for recruitment purposes and traveled twice to tournaments playing teams of all divisions: University of Texas, Texas Tech, Oklahoma Baptist University, Independence Community College, New Mexico University, and Oklahoma City University

2018-2019 – Begin recruitment for UT Tyler STUNT Team

Fall 2018 – Start practices with new recruiting class and Coach begins spring recruitment

Spring 2019 – Start first full season with first recruit class

Fall 2019 – Second recruiting class

Spring 2020 – Start second full season of STUNT games
