## 2022 Conferences and Divisions:

### **Division/Conference Game Guidelines:**

Season Requirements – 14 max dates of competition in the regular season, 6 dates of competition minimum for post season consideration and sports sponsorship. Max of 3 contests on one day of competition.

**Date of Competition:** A single date on which the institution's team engages in competition against an outside team.

### **Varsity Program Requirements:**

- Play every team in your conference at least 1 time. Independent(s) must play a minimum of 4 contests against different varsity programs.
- No more than 40% of your schedule may be played against non-varsity programs.
- If you play the same team more than twice, only the first two games will count towards both of your records and not count towards date of competition minimum but will count towards date of competition maximums.

**Varsity Program:** USA Cheer designates Varsity Programs as 4-year institutions operating fully under their athletic departments as a Varsity Sport. Their STUNT program has been accorded that status by the institution's president or chancellor or committee responsible for intercollegiate athletics policy and satisfies the following conditions:

1. It is a sport that is administered by the department of intercollegiate athletics.
2. It is a sport for which the eligibility of the student-athletes is reviewed and certified by a staff member designated by the institution's president or chancellor or committee responsible for intercollegiate athletics policy.
3. It is a sport in which qualified participants receive the institution's official varsity awards.

**Club Program:** USA Cheer designates a club program as a sport that has been accorded that status by an institution and satisfies the following conditions:

1. It is a sport that has not been accorded varsity status.
2. It is a sport in which student-athletes compete in intercollegiate athletics.

**STUNT National Championship:** Top Varsity NCAA Programs as outlined below:

1. The winner of each conference will be invited to the National Championship.
2. 1-2 at-large invites will be given based upon season wins/losses and strength of schedule. At large invites will be determined by the championship committee.

**STUNT Open Championship:** A minimum of 4 contests are required to be eligible for the championship. Divisions will be built out based upon the number of teams participating. A minimum of 4 teams are required to be considered for its own division. Example of potential divisions are as follows: NAIA, Club, Junior College.
