

Coach Bio: Michelle Sabourin, is in her 12th season as Head Cheer/STUNT Coach. In the emerging sport of STUNT, Alma has appeared at every College STUNT Association Championship since its second year as a program. The Scots placed second at STUNT Nationals in 2017, 2018, and 2019 while competing against D1 and D2 programs. The D3 championship was created in 2021 and the Scots have won the D3 STUNT national championship titles in 2021, 2022, and 2023. In 2014, Coach Sabourin was named USA Cheer's 2014 STUNT Coach of the Year. Sabourin earned her masters in coaching and athletic administration from Concordia University Irvine in 2018.

The Eagle STUNT team won the nation's first collegiate championship in 2023, the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Championships on the AU campus. Ashland also qualified for NCAA Division II STUNT nationals for the first time in 2023. Farnsworth was named 2023 Great Midwest Co-Coach of the Year. In the Eagle STUNT team's first full season in 2022, the team went 9-3, including a 16-0 win over Ursuline in the team's first home game at Kates Gymnasium.







Coach Bio: Powell enters her third season as the head coach of the Hiram Terriers Cheer & STUNT program in 2023-24, having joined the Terriers from Laurel Senior High School in New Castle, Pa., where she served as the assistant varsity cheer coach for the past two and a half years. Since beginning with Hiram, Powell has led the Terriers to a 14-9 record over the last two seasons, highlighted by a STUNT National Championship appearance in 2022 and a second-place finish in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Championship in 2023. The program joined the Great Midwest Athletic Conference ahead of the 2022-23 season, and finished 3-2 in games against conference competition that year.

Powell earned her bachelor's degree in political science and Spanish from the University of North Carolina at Wilmington in Wilmington, N.C. in 2010, and her master's degree in secondary education from Slippery Rock University in Slippery Rock, Pa. in 2017

**Season Highlights:** We have had such a fun season this year. We have so many little highlights that add up to being a great season. I love watching these girls work so hard and win points to show that their dedication is paying off.

Coach Bio: Joelle Bice became Muskingum's first-ever STUNT head coach in 2022. In its second full season, the team concluded the 2023 season with a 6-4 overall record and finished second ranked among DIII STUNT programs and made its first-ever appearance at the DIII STUNT National Championships and picked up its first-ever win at the national championships, topping Buena Viesta, 12-2. The historic season also marked the first time in program history that six members of the STUNT team were named to the CSCA All-American list. Bice has over 15 years of coaching and mentoring student-athletes in gymnastics, stunting, cheerleading, and dance and has previously worked as a UCA Instructor. She holds U.S. All Star Federation (USASF) Safety Certified Tumbling Levels 1-5 and USASF Safety Certified Stunting Levels 1-5.

**Season Highlights:** First year to beat D3 power house Alma. We have many freshman flyers on the mat at high, important levels and they are doing amazing! Great veteran leadership!

Coach Bio: Jessica Stiles took over as Cheer and STUNT Head Coach for the startup program in the spring of 2015. Stiles has also led the Bison to five straight appearances in the STUNT National Championships, finishing in the top four the last four seasons and ending the year as National Runner Up in 2021. The Bison have been in the Top 3 in the national rankings since 2018 and has produced seven All-American despite no team being announced since 2019 due to the pandemic.

Stiles was named the 2017 USA Cheer STUNT Division II National Coach of the Year after leading OBU to the STUNT National Championship for the second consecutive year.
