

## Frequently Asked Questions – College

### How do I get my STUNT Program membership?

### Do I need a STUNT Coach membership this year?

- No, it is not required that you have a STUNT Coach membership, but we highly recommend it. The STUNT Coach membership is \$30 and requires a background screening, safety certification, athlete protection training, and USA Cheer waiver. With a STUNT Coach membership, you will receive complimentary access to the new STUNT training pieces and discounted prices on other certifications USA Cheer offers.

### What is the minimum and maximum number of athletes needed to field a team?

- The recommended minimum number of athletes on a team is sixteen (16). This gives the team the opportunity to compete in all routines provided.
- There is no maximum number of athletes. Refer to your institution guidelines on number of athletes allowed to be on the sideline and travel team.

### What time of year do college games occur?

- STUNT is a spring sport and should follow the spring season. The typical spring season runs from February-early May.

### What is the number of contests required to be eligible for the championship?

- A member institution shall include a minimum of six (6) and maximum of fourteen (14) athletic dates of competition in its total playing schedule during the STUNT season.
  - A countable date of competition for a member institution is a single date on which the institution’s team engages in competition against an outside team, unless a specific exemption for a particular date of competition is set forth by rule.
  - A competition is any game, match or exhibition with another institution’s varsity or club team, regardless of its formality, in which competition occurs between an intercollegiate team representing an institution and any other team not representing the same intercollegiate program.

### How can I see the material for this season?

- Once you purchase your Program Membership for \$149, you will have immediate access to the “My Material” section of your membership. *Note: resources available depend on the release dates.*

### Has there been changes to any of the rules for this year?

- Yes, you can find all the changes listed in the **NEW** Rulebook.
