

Coach Bio: The Warriors went 0-8 in the first season of the program's existence. Jessup found success right away in year two, performing in front of fans for the first time on February 11 as they defeated Sacramento State for the first win in program history. Jessup jumped to No. 2 in the NAIA STUNT rankings, earning the second year program a spot in the STUNT National Championship. With STUNT Nationals taking place inside Warrior Arena, Jessup put on a show for their home fans as they won the NAIA STUNT National Championship with a 9-8 victory over reigning champs, Vanguard. Welch led the Warriors to a 13-5 record in the National Championship season. Prior to Jessup: Welch comes to the Warriors with a wealth of knowledge as a specialized coach in the STUNT student-athlete and coach. Hailing from Galt, Calif., Welch brought STUNT to her hometown, Liberty Ranch High School where she built the program from the ground up serving as the head coach for the past 5 years



Together with Robb and former head STUNT coach Allie Henshaw, Schott helped the Spartans launch a varsity STUNT program, which wrapped up a trip to the NAIA Division STUNT National Championship in its second year in existence. In addition to her role at MBU, Schott also works as Program Director and Head Cheer Coach at Flipside, coaching four elite teams.

In 2019, the team earned a berth in the STUNT Division II/III National Championships, finishing fourth overall. Coach Allen build on that success to grab a National Championship in 2021 and backed that up with a second-place finish in 2022. During her time at VU, she has coached 15 STUNT All-Americans and 19 STUNT Scholar Athletes. Allen returns to her roots in Orange County after spending the last two years at Ouachita Baptist University (OBU)
